



To Submit a Revised Paper for Peer Review

If you have received comments from the reviewers and been invited to submit a revised manuscript, you may need to reformat the paper along with the other suggested corrections.

Follow these guidelines to avoid the need for further revisions:

- Submit a point-by-point cover letter with your revised paper that details the changes made according to the reviewer comments and addresses the reviewer comments with which you disagree.
- Submit papers and figures electronically.
- Use Microsoft Word if possible as it is preferred for the text and figure captions. Add the figure captions in a list at the end of the text body as well as with the figures. LaTeX is also accepted.
- Submit figures as part of the main document (at the end, one per page) or as separate graphic files.
- The paper should be single column, 1.5- or double-spaced, with text in 10-point type.
- Format the revised manuscript according to the [Peer Review Paper Guidelines](#)
