KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA (26 June 2009). Early bird registration for the **Asia Pacific Oil & Gas Conference and Exhibition (APOGCE)** and **Asia Pacific Health, Safety, Security and Environment Conference and Exhibition (APHSSEC)** ends on **3 July 2009**. The Advance Registration deadline is **17 July 2009**. The conferences will be held at the Jakarta Convention Centre in Jakarta, Indonesia from 4-6 August 2009. SPE/IATMI expects over 4,000 people to attend this prestigious event supported by the Government Executive Agency for Upstream Oil & Gas Business Activities (BPMIGAS) and PT. PERTAMINA in Indonesia.

“As an industry, we face the challenge to satisfy the continuing global demand for hydrocarbons, while responding to the needs to address environmental concerns. “Leading the Energy Challenges with Care and Responsibility” was the chosen theme focusing on bringing together the leading players in these two fields” remarked Abdul Muin, 2009 APOGCE and APHSSEC General Chairman and Vice Chairman, BPMIGAS.

The President of the Republic of Indonesia, H.E. Dr. H. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono will deliver the Welcome address and officiate the opening of 2009 APOGCE and APHSSEC. H.E. Dr. Purnomo Yusgiantoro, Indonesian Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources will attend along with the 2009 SPE President, Leo Roodhart and IATMI President, Bagus Sudaryanto.

After the Opening Ceremony a joint Keynote Session will be held for the conference delegates. H.E. Professor Rachmat Witoelar, State Minister of Environment, Indonesia has confirmed to provide the opening session speech. R. Priyono, Chairman, BPMIGAS; Karen Augustiawan, President and CEO of PT. PERTAMINA (Persero); and Steve Green, President, Chevron Indonesia Company have all confirmed to speak at the Keynote session.

APOGCE features 19 technical sessions, one (1) plenary session and two (2) panel sessions. The Plenary session will address ‘The Rise of NOCs’, and the two panel sessions will focus on ‘LNG’ and ‘Coal Bed Methane (CBM) and Coal Seam Gas’ (CSG). Technical sessions include Drilling and Completion Technologies, Field Development, IOR/EOR, Reservoir Management and Production Optimisation and case studies.

APHSSEC features 11 technical sessions, focussing on HSE management and issues, featuring industry experts and professionals, one (1) plenary session and seven (7) panel sessions. The Plenary session topic ‘Growth, Care and Responsibility’ will focus on the

conference theme, while the Panel sessions will cover the health, safety, security and environmental management and issues. The Panel Sessions include Impact of Climate Change on Health; Public Health: Impact on the Workforce; Leadership and Behaviour; Contractor Safety; Country Risk Assessment and Community Based Security; Clean Development Mechanism (CarbonTrade); and Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in a Sustainable Energy Industry. The conference format facilitates maximum knowledge sharing and networking opportunities.

To enhance the technical programme, daily topical luncheons will feature presentations related to the conference theme. A luncheon presentation will be delivered by Terry S. McPhail, President and General Manager, ExxonMobil Oil Indonesia Inc. on Tuesday, 4 August 2009 and Azhar Noordin, Senior General Manager, HSE Group, PETRONAS will speak on Wednesday, 5 August 2009.

The conference will feature a number of social activities including a welcome reception, poster session reception and a conference dinner.

A joint exhibition will be held concurrently in the convention centre. For the first time, the exhibit will feature a 'technology presentation theatre' which will allow qualified exhibitors the opportunity to present their latest technological advances. Young Professionals Workshop (Monday, 3 August 2009)

The programme is designed to cater for tertiary qualified oil and gas professionals under the age of 35 years or with less than 10 years industry experience. Industry professionals will be invited to share their experience and present talks on topics of general interest and relevance to the industry.

Regional Student Paper Contest (Tuesday, 4 August 2009)

The Regional Student Paper Contest offers students pursuing degrees relating to the oil and gas industry from the Asia Pacific region the opportunity to present papers to a technical review panel. Winners will be invited to compete with other regional winners at the SPE International Finals to be held at the 2010 SPE Annual Technical Conference and Exhibition (ATCE) in Florence, Italy.
