Intelligent Completions

Intelligent completions are no longer exclusively for large, deepwater or highly leveraged fields. Advances in reliability and standardization of design have put these solutions within reach of land operations. As the number of field applications continues to increase, intelligent completion technology has matured, offering a flexible range of options. Costs are decreasing as reliability and flexibility continue to improve. Off-the-shelf solutions can be applied for both measurement and production optimization in a variety of cost scenarios, making these solutions viable as an enhanced recovery technology.

Aimed at operator and service companies interested in novel solutions for enhancing recovery or monitoring downhole conditions, this Emerging Technology Workshop will explore the key factors that determine if an intelligent completion is warranted for a particular field. Discussions about data gathering, mechanical, retrievable, and reusable solutions will follow brief, informal case study presentations.
