From the MSF CHARTER

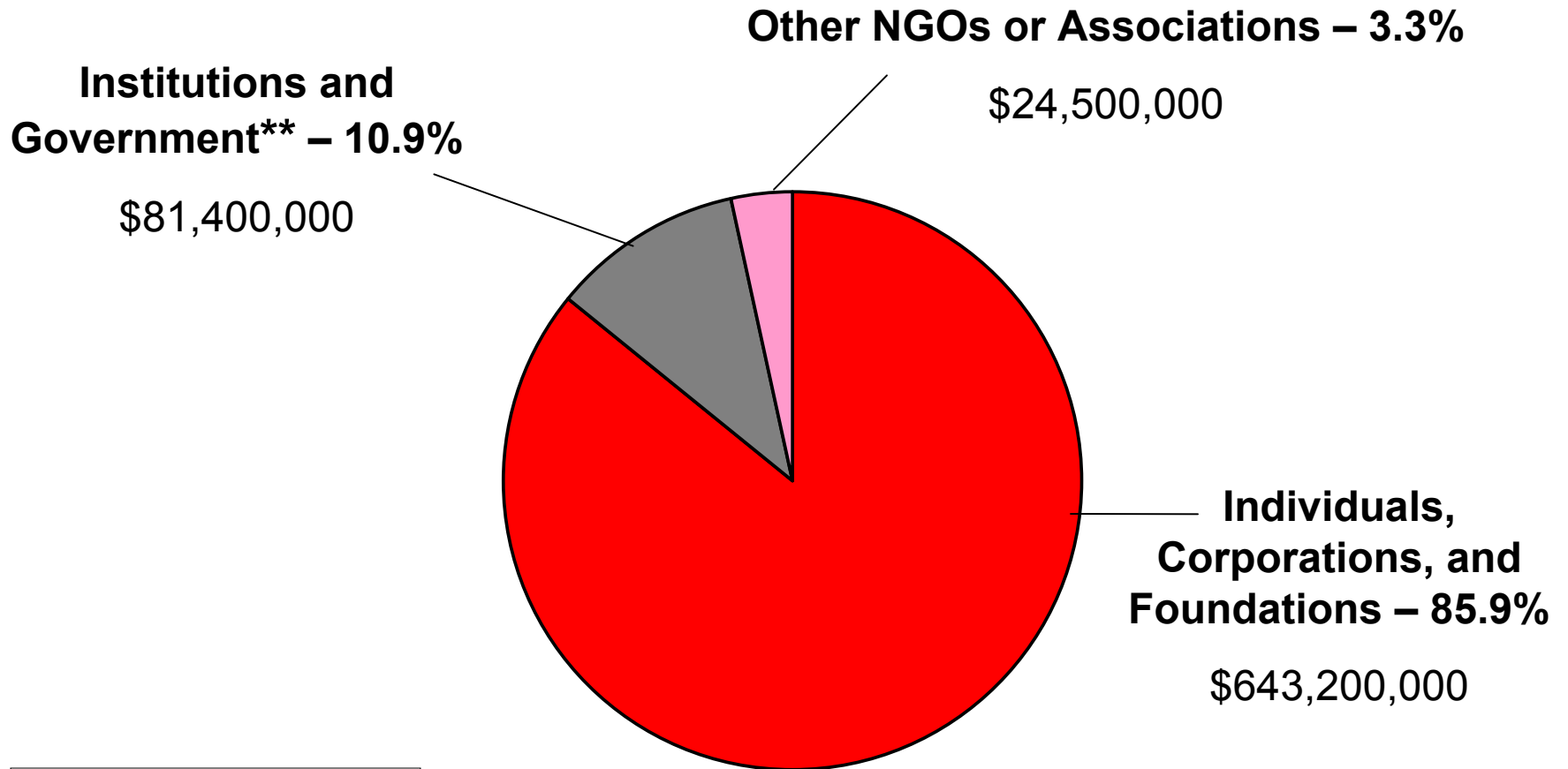

Médecins Sans Frontières observes **neutrality** and **impartiality** in the name of universal medical ethics and the right to humanitarian assistance and claims full and unhindered freedom in the exercise of its functions.

Members undertake to respect their professional code of ethics and to maintain complete **independence** from all political, economic, or religious powers.

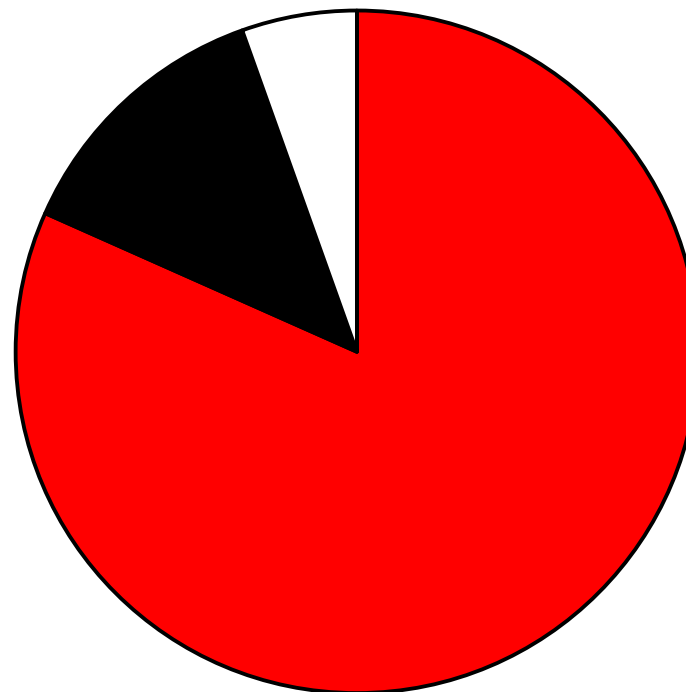

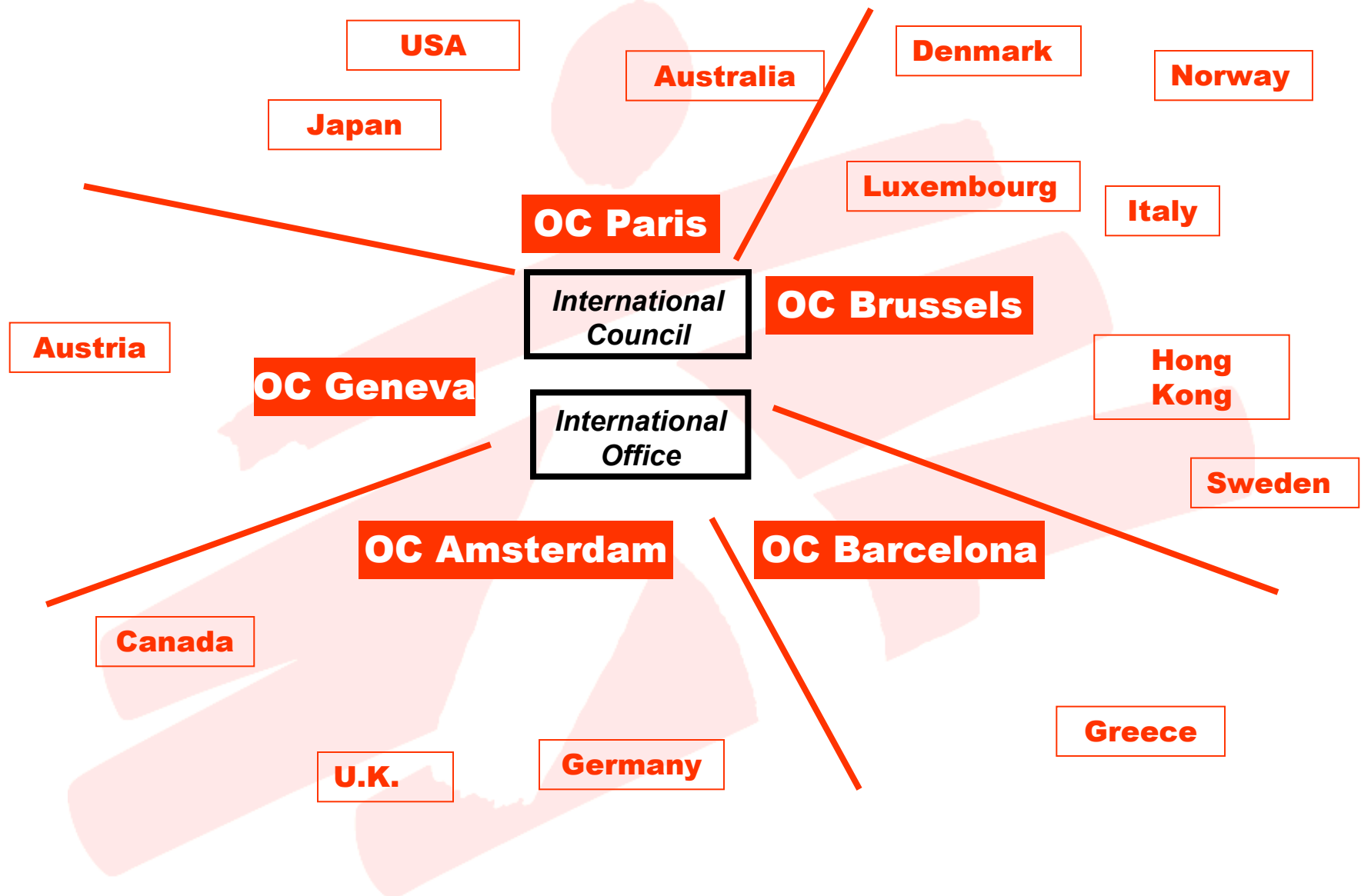

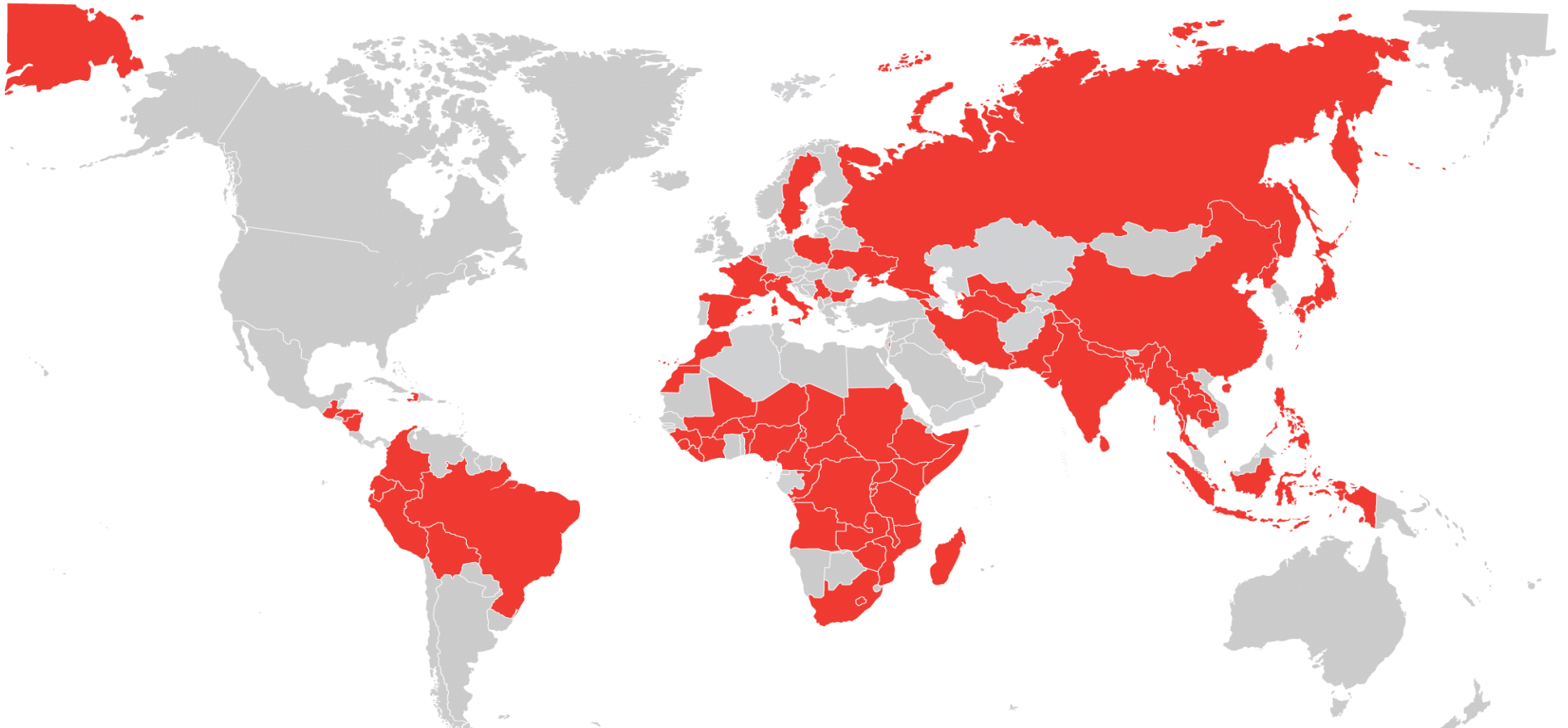

- **Medical programs in nearly 60 countries**
