

How Access Has Changed for IP-Validated Subscribers

If your company or university is a subscriber to the eLibrary and has been using IP-validation, your method of accessing the eLibrary has changed.

Previously, you needed to go to a link on your organization's intranet. It transferred you to a page on SPE.org that validated your IP address and automatically logged you in with your corporate ID. But if you ever tried to go to the Membership Directory or other restricted resources on SPE.org, you had to logout and log in again as yourself.

Now, you'll just come straight to <http://www.spe.org>.

1. You will log in as yourself.
2. We will recognize your IP address as belonging to your organization, and give you access to your corporate/university subscription.
3. You'll be able to do anything you need to do on the website (register for a meeting, go to the Membership Directory, etc.) seamlessly, while still taking advantage of subscription pricing in the eLibrary.

Once you've used the website from your corporate IP, you can be "roaming" for a period of up to 2 weeks from the last time you accessed the eLibrary from your office. That means you can still access the eLibrary while you are traveling, even though you are in a hotel or otherwise not on a corporate IP.

If you are an SPE member or have previously registered for a meeting through our website, you already have a login. If not, it is easy to get one. Just click New User Registration at the bottom of the login form. Your login will be your email address, and your password can be virtually anything you want it to be (no special characters, please). That means your login will be easy to remember even if you don't use it often.

Some companies may choose to handle their subscription differently, so if you have questions about access, please check with the administrator of your corporate/university subscription.

Remember: If your company has a subscription and you see pricing on papers when you get to View Cart – you need to log in.
