New: Safety Leadership Academy

Join SPE and CEDEP for a first-of-its-kind experience for industry leaders charged with making zero a reality within their organizations.

The program leverages key research from SPE and IOGP, as well as CEDEP's expertise in leadership education, to extend and further enhance the oil and gas industry's safety performance fundamentals. The unique 3-phase program uses a strong learner-centered methodology which includes individual and group coaching.

The end goal is to create a close-knit community of leaders and aspiring leaders poised to tackle and effectively lead the grand challenges of Getting to Beyond Zero.

Program Format

- Phase one is a four-day, in-person session focused on overcoming current realities to shift your perspective and approach with others within your organization—Leading Self and Leading Others.
- Phase two includes an in-work knowledge application supported by virtual meetings and one-on-one coaching to share experiences and reinforce learning.
- Phase three reconvenes participants for a final four-day session focused on extending your influence and affecting change within your organization's culture.
