## Captains of Industry Champion Oil and Gas Upstream Technical Advancements

Jakarta, Indonesia (5 March 2015) – The Asia Pacific Oil and Gas Conference and Exhibition (APOGCE) will be held from 20 to 22 October 2015 at the Bali Nusa Dua Convention Center in Bali, Indonesia.
