NEW REQUIREMENTS for 2022

- **Existing candidates and regional recipient transitions for international awards must be transitioned to the new form**
 - Log in to the platform and complete the required fields
 - The old form is available as a reference on the attachments tab
- **All nominations must be accompanied by the candidate CV/resume or LinkedIn profile**
 - Candidate will receive an email with a link when the new form is submitted
- **All nominations must have at least one letter of support**
 - You may request up to 6 letters of support
 - You can monitor the status, send reminders, and change out requests

WHY DOES THE SPE HAVE AN AWARDS PROGRAM



- **Peer recognition** is an important program of every professional organization.
 - SPE Awards Program recognizes members at the **regional and international level**
 - SPE Awards Program is intended for **members to recognize their colleagues**
 - SPE Awards Program is **nominator driven**. Candidates **must** be nominated and then recommended by the award subcommittee to receive an award.



SPE AWARDS PROGRAM MUST MEET THESE PRINCIPLES:



Candidates are judged solely on **merit**.



Committee members are **unbiased** and working for the **general good of SPE**



The process of recipient selection is **fair and transparent**.



All discussion by selection committee members during deliberations is **confidential**.



Nominations are **managed by the nominator** only



No Self-nomination



SPE awards recognize accomplishments of **individuals**

3 STEP PROCESS SUMMARY



Nominators

SPE member submits nominations, determines category, owns and manages the nomination content, responsible for any change in a nomination



Judges

Appointed SPE members review eligible nominations, deliberate, vote on recommended recipient, maintain confidentiality



Board of Directors

Full board responsible for final approval of judges' recommendations for international award recipients. Regional recipients approved by Regional Directors

All acting in the best interest of SPE

WHEN DO WE BEGIN? WHEN DO WE FINISH?



- **September** – Nominations open
- **15 February** – International award nomination deadline
- **1 March** – Regional award nomination deadline
- **15 March** – Begin award nomination reviews
- **July** – Recipients announced on SPE.org
- **TBA** – Regional award recipients presented at RD discretion
- **3–5 October 2022**– international awards presented at ATCE in Houston TX

WHAT ARE MY REGIONAL AWARDS?

- **Regional Technical Awards**
- **Regional Public Service Award**
- **Regional Service Award – per region count depends on region membership**
- **Young Professional Outstanding Service Award – 2 per region**
- **Regional Distinguished Corporate Support Award**

- **The Regional Awards are eligible for 1 year. Candidates must be renominated annually**

WHO IS QUALIFIED FOR A REGIONAL AWARD? THEY MUST...



- Be a **paid professional** member of the SPE.
 - Nonmembers, former members, student members are ineligible
- Be a **living person** on 1 January of the year of presentation.
- **Reside in the region** for at least 7 months
- **Not served as an officer** or director of SPE International within 24 months of award
- **Not be a recipient of**
 - International Award equivalent
 - any SPE major award
 - of this same award in the same region in the last 5 years
 - Honorary Membership
- **Comply** with the SPE sanction policy
- **Be nominated by a colleague**

WHAT ABOUT INTERNATIONAL AWARDS?



- Regional recipients → International candidates
- Nominators can log in to
 - Enhance the international nominations:
 - Add additional detail to make nomination more competitive
 - Add letters of recommendation
- You can encourage nominators in your section to update candidate info, explain why it is important:
 - International awards candidates are global
 - Contest is more competitive
 - Judges are diverse and global – they may not know your candidate
 - Every international recipient is in a section – just like your members!
- International awards stay in the candidate pool for 3 years

WHAT ARE THE SPE MAJOR AWARDS?

- **Direct nominations are required for most major awards:**
 - **Honorary Membership** - .1% of SPE members
 - **Distinguished Membership** – 1 % of SPE members
 - **John Franklin Carll Award** – Distinguished professionals
 - **Anthony F. Lucas Gold Medal** – Technical leadership
 - **Lester C. Uren Award** – Technical excellence before 45 years of age
 -  **Charles F. Rand Memorial Gold Medal** – Mining administration including petroleum
 -  **Robert Earll McConnell Award** – engineer's beneficial service to mankind that advances standard of living
 - **DeGolyer Distinguished Service Medal** – Service to SPE, industry, and geology
 - **Giovanni Paccaloni Young Professional Service Award**- Service to the **COMMUNITY**, SPE and the industry under age 36

HOW CAN MEMBERS IN MY SECTION PARTICIPATE INTERNATIONALLY ?

- **Direct nominations may be made for any international award**
 - Most SPE major awards **must** be nominated directly – no regional equivalent
- **Encourage direct nominations** to have members from your section represented in the candidate pools
 - Section presence in the recipient list depends on having candidates in the nomination pool
- Qualifications vary by award

WHAT ARE MY RESOURCES?

 - Serve on Nominating Committees, Volunteer for Judging Committees
- **Informz**
 - Officers can communicate with section members
- **Membership Builder**
 - To research and identify good candidates
- **SPE Member profiles**
 - To help compose robust nominations –these are now available to nominators through a link in the form
- **www.SPE.org/awards to access help, FAQs nomination portal**
- **Your Technical Activities Manager and Awards Team Members**
 - To help you, your nomination committees, your members get involved in recognition
- **A&R Manager**
 - Q&A presentations to your advisory and nominating committees
 - Encourage members to recognize excellence in SPE
